Math Workshop (3:45 - 4:30 PM) - Room B

Experience a new practical approach to math problem solving and hands-on practice for 3rd -8th graders. This class teaches foundational math and time management skills, whether your student needs chapter review, assistance on a new topic for school or help preparing for tests. AGI is here to help. Critical Reading and Written Expression (3:00 - 3:45 PM) - Room B
