RETOOLING YOUR GOVERNMENT DURING AN EMERGENCY TO BETTER SERVE YOU

CITY HALL AND THE EL MONTE POLICE STATION WILL BE CLOSED TO THE PUBLIC IN RESPONSE TO COVID-19. ALL EMERGENCY SERVICES WILL STILL BE PROVIDED AND AVAILABLE.

The restrictions will take effect in the City of El Monte beginning on March 16, 2020, and will remain in place through noon on March 31, 2020. **They are subject to extension.**

The following establishments within the City of El Monte will be temporarily closed to the public:

- **Bars and nightclubs that do not serve food;**
- **Entertainment venues;**
- **Bowling alleys and arcades; and**
- **Gyms and fitness centers.**

The following restrictions will also apply:

- **All restaurants shall prohibit dining in, but may continue to prepare and offer food via delivery service or take-out and drive-thru;**
- **Houses of worship are urged to limit large gatherings on their premises and to explore and implement ways to practice their respective faiths while observing social distancing practices.**

The following establishments will continue to operate:

- **Grocery stores will continue to operate. There is no shortage of food or interruption in our food supply;**
- **Cafeterias within hospitals, nursing homes, and similar facilities will continue operations.**
