

ORDINANCE NO. 2523

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY
OF EL MONTE, CALIFORNIA, AMENDING SECTIONS
2.04.030 AND 2.08.010 OF THE EL MONTE MUNICIPAL
CODE

The City Council of the City of El Monte does hereby ordain as follows:

Section 1. El Monte Municipal Code §2.04.030 is hereby amended to read:

“2.04.030 Council Members Salaries.

Each member of the city council shall receive a salary during each month in which he or she is a member of the city council. The amount of such salary shall be six hundred sixty five dollars (\$665.00) per month, representing the amount specified in the last salary adjustment operative on January 23, 1990 in accordance with Ordinance No. 2285, to which shall be added the further sum of \$66.50 pursuant to Government Code §36516(a)(4) as provided below. The monthly salary herein set forth shall be applicable during the month (or portion of a month) for which said salary is due; provided, however, that the increase of \$66.50 per month herein specified shall become applicable as of April 15, 2001, unless sooner authorized by the State Legislature.”

Section 2. El Monte Municipal Code §2.08.010 is hereby amended to read:


“2.04.010 Mayor’s Salary


The mayor shall receive a salary during each month in which he or she is a member of the city council. The amount of such salary shall be six hundred sixty five dollars (\$665.00) per month, representing the amount specified in the last salary adjustment operative on January 23, 1990 in accordance with Ordinance No. 2285, to which shall be added the further sum of \$66.50 pursuant to Government Code §36516(a)(4) as provided below. The monthly salary herein set forth shall be applicable during the month (or portion of a month) for which said salary is due; provided, however, that the increase of \$66.50 per month herein specified shall become applicable as of April 15, 2001, unless sooner authorized by the State Legislature.”

Section 3. Separability. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this ordinance is held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such determination shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance. The City Council declares that it would have enacted this ordinance and each section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase hereof irrespective of any determination of invalidity.


