As required by law, the El Monte City Council hereby gives notice that a public hearing will be held on **Tuesday, April 21, 2009** to determine whether or not the following matter should be approved:

APPROVAL SOUGHT: Approval of a City-initiated ballot measure to be placed on the County-administered Special General Election ballot of Tuesday, July 14, 2009 for consideration and approval by El Monte voters.

The proposed ballot measure would establish a new parcel tax on real property in the City of El Monte. Revenues generated by the parcel tax will be restricted to paying for fire and paramedic response services in the City of El Monte with the objective of preserving current levels of service, including paramedic response times, and preserving the operation of existing fire station facilities.

Related to the aforementioned action will be the approval of all related resolutions and authorizations calling a special municipal ballot measure election and requesting consolidation of the same with the County-administered Special General Election contest for the 32nd U.S. Congressional Seat to be held Tuesday, July 14, 2009.
