



Pool/Facility Rules

1. All swimmers must wear regulation swim suits. No rental suits available.
2. All swimmers must shower before entering pool.
3. No personal flotation devices or jewelry permitted in the pool.
4. Children 6 years and under must have an adult with them in the pool at all times during recreation swim and specified lessons.
5. All swimmers 3 years and under must wear an in-water diaper designed for swimming. Swimmers 3-5 years of age must wear an in-water diaper if they are not toilet trained.
6. All spectators must sit in designated areas.
7. Special events/facility bookings may cause a change in the posted schedule.
8. The City of El Monte is not responsible for lost or stolen items. Valuables should be properly secured, stored, or left at home.
9. Food and drink consumption only allowed in designated areas.
10. Gum, outside food, drinks, and glass containers are not allowed.
11. A swim test is required to swim in deep-water areas.
12. Please walk at all times. No running is allowed.
13. No diving except from diving boards. Please enter pool feet first and facing forward only.
14. For the safety of all patrons, please comply with requests made by lifeguards and staff.
15. Pool Closure: Occasionally the pool may close due to unexpected incidents, inclement weather or facility bookings.
16. Due to deck space and supervision, strollers must be kept in designated area and will not be allowed during recreation swim.
17. No coaching or private instruction allowed at any time.
18. Absolutely no photography or video recording with any equipment is permitted in locker rooms.
19. The El Monte Aquatic Center reserves the right to cancel any class that falls below the minimum required enrollment.
20. All students MUST show a registration card to enter the facility. A \$5 fee will be assessed for a replacement card.
21. Classes will stop admitting students 15 minutes after class has begun.
22. **ALL SALES ARE FINAL.** Account credits, exchanges, or make-ups will only be allowed in the event of a medical emergency with proper medical documentation. All other considerations must be approved and granted by the Aquatics Supervisor with a 50% service charge for account credits and a \$10 service charge for exchanges.

The El Monte Aquatic Center has a structured lesson program which complies with the American Red Cross guidelines.
